Narrated 'Abdullah ibn Umar (Radi'allahu anhu): The Prophet (Sallallahu alaihi wa sallam) said:

"The Salaah (prayer) in congregation is twenty-seven times superior in degrees to the Salaah prayed alone."

(Collected by Imaam al-Bukharee)

NOTE: The above timings are only estimates; the actual times are according to the *Sunnah* based on human sightings (see *Bulughul-Maraam** for guidelines in determining the start and end times of each Salaah (prayer)).

Abu Dharr (ra) said: The Prophet (PBUH) came out in the winter when the leaves were falling. He took a branch off the tree and the leaves began to fall off it. He (PBUH) said: "O Abu Dharr." I said: At your service O Messenger of Allaah. He (PBUH) said: "Indeed the muslim servant performs a prayer, desiring by it nothing but the face of Allaah and his sins fall from him just like these leaves fall from this tree."

Abu Hurairah (ra) also said: The Messenger of Allaah (PBUH) said: "The five prayers and one Jumu'ah to the next are an expiation for what is between them, as long as no major sins are committed." [Muslim]

Abu Hurairah also The Messenger of Allaah (PBUH) said: passed by a grave and said: "Who is the companion of this grave?" They said: So and so. So he said: "Two rakah are more loved by him than what remains in your world." [at-Tabaraanee, Hasan]
